## What is SCA?

For many decades now, **SCA International** has operated ministry centres committed to investing in the lives of young people. SCA International camps emphasize evangelism, discipleship, leadership development through service, and stewardship. The impact of SCA's ministry is far-reaching. There are many adults, now working in a variety of fields, who can point to one of our SCA ministry centres and especially the camping sessions they experienced there as a place and time where they gained valuable life lessons, grew in confidence, gained acceptance, and encountered God.



### SCA Eagle Bay Ministry Centre & Camp Hilbre, MB

Today, well over 600 campers attend SCA camps each summer and are encouraged to grow and develop as a whole person created by God — mentally, emotionally, socially and spiritually. The person who sent you this brochure is excited to be a part of this influential ministry in rural and isolated Canada. They are ready to be used by God as a role model to young people and to be “Jesus with skin on” for them — collectively, our short-term staff may well be the only Jesus they will see in their young lives.

SCA International is a non-profit organization where the short-term staff serves as volunteers. These young people are willingly giving up an opportunity to earn the necessary finances for their schooling during the summer to serve the Lord with SCA. With that in mind, SCA International is encouraging these volunteers to raise funds through its Short-Term Staff Program.

## How does this work?

The support received on the Volunteer's behalf will be placed in a Missions Fund, in their name. Every month, volunteers will be issued a cheque for the amount that they have raised and has been received in our Head Office up to 30 days after the completion of their term of service.

**SCA International** deducts a 7.0% assessment from each donation to cover administrative and receipting costs. Regular Employee Payroll costs (any applicable CPP and EI deductions) will also be deducted in keeping with the requirements of Canada's Revenue Agency.
