Much of our ministry is discipling, one-on-one, as the Lord leads. We find so many people who have received salvation, but have never grown. We visited with one lady who, right after her salvation several years ago, Jean invited into a Bible study. About three months after her salvation, we helped her get to a "Wholeness Through Christ" prayer ministry course. She is still walking strongly for the Lord, and credits that to the discipling she received. She's a vigorous advocate for early discipling! We also minister to people in very difficult situations. One couple we worked with was pretty dysfunctional, so our ministry to them was teaching the Bible, the Gospel, some life skills, as well as giving practical help. Another family has been going through some conflict with a teenager, and our presence for both the teenager and the parents has been appreciated.

God sees the big picture and we want to follow His leading to the lives of the people He puts in our paths. We praise Him for the work He is doing.
